

Résumé Steef Blok - 2019



Steef Blok MSc (1956) is managing director of the valorization center of the Technical University of Eindhoven (TU/e Innovation Lab). He studied business economics at the Erasmus University in Rotterdam.

In the past Steef Blok worked as head of financial reporting at the Erasmus University of Rotterdam from 1983 until 1987. After that he was managing director clinical divisions of the Academic Hospital Rotterdam and the Erasmus Medical Center (MC) Rotterdam until 2000.

In 1999 he became financial director of the faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences at the Erasmus University Rotterdam. From 2002 until 2008 he had different positions at the Erasmus MC, being head of the department of Knowledge Transfer, director of the Erasmus Medical Center Holding B.V., director of the Erasmus Medical Center Incubator, initiator and advisor of the Erasmus Medical Center Biomedical Fund and project leader of the SKE-project 'Rotterdam works'. From 2008 until 2010 he was employed at the University Amsterdam (VU) and the VU MC Amsterdam as general director of Technology Transfer Offices of the VU and the VU MC, as director of the Boelevaar Holding B.V. and director of the Ooievaar Holding B.V.

Since March 2010, he is managing director of the TU/e Innovation Lab, part of the Eindhoven University of Technology, project leader of Incubator 3+, member of the Supervisory Board of the Dutch Polymer Institute, business developer at the Intelligent Lighting Institute and co-founder of the Dutch TTP-Association, for technology transfer personnel.

Besides that, he is director of different companies since 1995.
